

Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery Children's Festival School Banners

Be part of the 2019 TMAG Children's Festival by creating an artwork with your school group.

This year the TMAG Children's Festival theme is **EARTHTIME!** TMAG is inviting school groups to create artworks on large banners. These will be displayed on TMAG's outdoor railings during the festival from Friday, 12 to Wednesday, 17 April 2019. Each banner will be accompanied by a label acknowledging the school group.

TMAG will provide participating schools with a large banner and paint to create an artwork of their choice with their group, to be returned to TMAG by Monday, **1 April**.

Banners are limited and will be sent out on a first come, first serve basis, as schools apply. We can only accept one entry per school to allow the maximum number of schools to participate.

TMAG will provide:

- 1 banner (varying sizes)
- 5 x 250mL tubs of water based interior house paint
- Delivery of banner and paints to your school
- A postal package for returning your banner to TMAG (if required)

What you and your students need to do:

- Create an artwork together on your banner during Term 1
- Make sure the banner is painted in 'landscape' orientation
- Provide a short statement (max. 100 words) written with your group about the artwork
- Return your banner artwork to TMAG by **1 April 2019**

Important dates:

- You can sign up to receive a banner until **22 February**, however banners will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis – so act quickly! TMAG will notify schools if they are successful or not.
- Banners will be delivered the week of **25 February**
- Banners are to be returned to TMAG by **1 April** at the latest

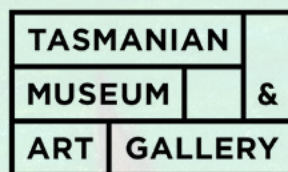

- Schools are able to keep their banners after the TMAG Children's Festival. It will be the responsibility of the school/teacher to collect and return their banner.
- Pick up is from TMAG Custom House, 19 Davey St, Hobart. Hours are 8:30 am – 5:00 pm Monday to Thursday and 8:30 am – 4:00 pm Friday.
